### **WHERE TO GET A FREE FLU SHOT:**

The Umatilla County Public Health Department is holding a **FREE FLU CLINIC** for residents of Umatilla County --

It is recommended that all residents 60 years and older, high-risk individuals 19 years and older, pregnant women, children age 1 through 4 years old, and children under 18 with high-risk conditions get their flu shot every year --

On the following dates the Umatilla County Public Health Dept. along with Good Shepard Medical Center, St. Anthony Hospital and other emergency agencies from around Umatilla County will be conducting a **FREE FLU CLINIC** --

**Nov. 7<sup>th</sup> at Hawthorne School in Pendleton,**

**Nov. 8<sup>th</sup> at Thompson Hall in Hermiston,**

**Nov. 13<sup>th</sup> at the Community Building in Milton-Freewater.**

All clinic dates will run from **8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

Umatilla County assisted living homes, nursing homes and senior citizen organization that will be bringing multiple residents in vans or busses can call for loading and unloading directions for each of the facilities. For those that can not load and/or unload at the clinic site, call for curb side in vehicle vaccination availability.
