



# Farmers Market Food Vendors

## Licensing Fees

**More than 48 hours before the event**  
**1 day=\$48.00**  
**2-30 calendar days=\$66**  
**Benevolent=\$30.00**

**Less than 48 hours before the event**  
**1 day=\$96.00**  
**2-30 calendar days=\$114.00**  
**Benevolent=\$42.00**

(Will need to renew throughout season)

Food and single service items (i.e. paper cups, paper plates, etc) must be purchased the day of the event **OR** be stored in a licensed commissary if they are held from one week to the next. Date marking may apply. Food stored at home or in a unlicensed kitchen is strictly **prohibited**.



Food prep must be done on site the day of the event or in a licensed commissary.



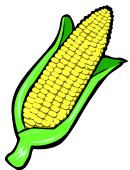
Food must be purchased from an approved source, including ice.



Dish washing must be done in a 3 compartment sink on site or in a licensed commissary.



It is recommended that any equipment be stored in plastic containers with lids from one week to the next to prevent any contamination during travel or storage.

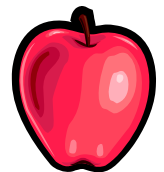


This license is applicable only for 1 farmers market. For example, if a vendor is licensed for Pendleton Farmers Market they may not use the license for any other event or Farmers Market. Fee must be paid in advance.



If it is your intention to prepare or store food in a licensed commissary an agreement form must be signed and made available during inspections

**Commissary:** a commissary catering establishment, restaurant, or any other place in which food, beverage, ingredients, containers, or supplies are kept, handled, packaged, prepared or stored. These facilities are licensed and undergo an inspection by either the County Health Department of Oregon Department of Agriculture.
