



We would like you to be apart of the Annual Festival of Lights. By being a vendor at our Holiday Craft Bazaar which will be held in Thompson Hall.

If you are planning on being here please fill out the attached application and drop it by the office!

November 27th the day after Thanksgiving will be the Kick Off of the Festival of Lights! The Parade will start at 6pm and goes from Newport Park to the Fairgrounds. (As a vendor you will still need to be ready to go by 5pm.)

We ask that you are in place ready to go at 5:00PM and stay in place until 9:00PM on Friday/ Saturday and Sunday please stay in place until 8:00PM. All vehicles must be off the Fairgrounds by 4:45pm and will not be allowed back on during our public hours. Thompson Hall will be closed at 8:30pm on Sunday, if you need additional time to disassemble you will need to make arrangements to come in that next Monday.

Remember you will need to provide everything for your space, from the table covering to any displays. We supply a table and 2 chairs. If you need plug-ins please be sure to let us know right away. Please consider making your space as attractive as possible.

*You may leave your merchandise (**COVERED**) at night in the building until the next day. If your weekends scheduled are not consecutive then you must completely remove your merchandise from the building the last night of the scheduled week. The building will only stay open an additional 30 minutes after the grounds and bazaar close.*

*Night staff will be the only one with keys and it is imperative no one will be allowed to stay in the building or on Fairgrounds. Your booth must be manned at all times. Umatilla County, The Fairgrounds, and Fair Board will **NOT** be responsible for your money, or your merchandise/displays. If you have small items or expensive merchandise we would **HIGHLY** recommend that you remove it nightly.*

The Hermiston High School Photography Club will be taking pictures of families with Santa, and there will also be Complimentary Hot Chocolate. Carriage & Wagon rides will be running throughout the weekend as well as all the light displays. We'll see you soon!
