This includes providing an upgrade to the current officer dining space along with a new kitchen oven and kettle. If Umatilla County decides to include the capital investment and select the 2,600 calorie menu, the following outlines the new pricing scale. Please note that this proposed pricing still provides a meal cost savings of \$0.204

 As requested in the RFP, our allinclusive pricing has been presented as price per meal (PPM) based on the population scale parameters specified below. Please note, we have proposed two menu rotations, each with an oven replacement option and an oven and dishwasher replacement option for a total of 4 options tailored to meet your needs!



- There are many factors that influence the price per meal but the two largest are the quality of the menu and staffing. We have specifically designed and proposed quality, nutritious ACA certified menu options for the inmates and have incorporated all nutritional items called out in the RFP and in meetings with you. We have also proposed what we know to be the proper staffing and compensation plans that will ensure satisfaction and stability for the Umatilla County operation.
- We have also proposed our extremely

As noted above and shown in the following cost tables, we have entered four pricing options for your consideration. Please note, these prices **include** all staffing, food products, paper items and chemicals associated with the food service operations. Pricing also includes all dietician services, menu development support, our proprietary kitchen management/food production software! Pricing is broken out by the two different menu rotations (HHH and HHC) and the two pieces of needed equipment so that Umatilla County can select whatever options best meets your needs!

Whatever pricing option Umatilla County selects, all staff meal costs are **included** in the inmate price per meal.

Should Umatilla County wish to negotiate this pricing further we are more than happy to discuss.

Capital Investment

Trinity's price proposal in options (A) and (B) includes a capital investment of \$6,800.00 for the oven as identified in the RFP and proposed on page 43 of our response. Additionally, In price proposal options (C) and (D) we have included a capital investment of \$24,544.00 for the oven replacement as well as a new dishwasher as proposed on pages 44-58 of our response. This proposed equipment can be reviewed and modified as best needed for Umatilla County and the final decisions will be at the discretion of your agency. Trinity would amortize this equipment over a 3-year contract period, and we would require buyback protection for this equipment should the contract end prematurely.

Commission Rate

We will pay 25% commission on all commissionable sales for commissary items. Non-commissionable sales (postage, tax, indigent items/kits, phone and tablet time) are not included. We will pay commission by invoicing the full sales amount less commission. This 25% commission also includes friends and family web ordering through Securepak.

Account Management

Umatilla County Jail's dedicated account manager, David Nicholson, will oversee the commissary operation as the liaison between Keefe and designated Jail personnel.

Software/Hardware

We will provide the necessary Keefe software for inmates to purchase commissary on the GTL tablets. We will pay for the costs associated to develop the interface between Keefe and JMS provider. We also will include an onsite workstation setup to assist with processing credits, looking up orders, making adjustments to the menus and answering concerns forms. Our Online Banking software is also included in this proposal. All of this will be provided at no cost to the facility.
