2024-2025 Budget Transfers

Scheduled for June 18, 2025

Thirteen Budget Transfers are scheduled for consideration on June 18, 2025. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

Budget Order 2025-74 Community Corrections

The <u>**Community Corrections Program</u>** requires a Budget Transfer to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Capital Outlay of \$100,000, and a decrease in Contingency of \$100,000.</u>

Budget Order 2025-75 General Fund - BOC

The <u>General Fund - BOC Program</u> requires a Budget Transfer to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of \$65,000, and a decrease in Contingency of \$65,000.
