Committee members present: Jack Bascomb, Brad Bixler, and Dan Dorran. Cindy Wood sat in as a community member. Jerry Terjeson was out of town.

Committee acting-chair, Brad Bixler called the meeting to order at 2:52 pm.

Jack Bascomb moved to approve the minutes from the April 1th, 2021 HELP Committee meeting. Correction of spelling of Dan Dorran's name. Dan Dorran seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 4-0 vote.

Old Business:

The committee reviewed the 2021 HELP projects.

Brad Bixler presented the Helix School District 2021 fund request for \$21,500 (see attached application). The District would like to spend \$9,000 on Elnora Baker Memorial Rose Garden, \$5,300 on Technology to begin the replacement of Promethean Boards and projectors in the elementary classrooms with an ActivPanel touch screens, \$4,700 for irrigation installing underground systems in the grass area on the baseball field, and \$2,250 for new front entrance lights. All projects were completed with the exception of the irrigation on the baseball field.

Brad Bixler made a request for reimbursement of \$19,492.59.

Jack Bascomb presented the City of Helix 2021 fund request for **\$21,250** (see attached application). Various projects were discussed: The City's project was to chip seal several of the streets in town (Columbia, Harrison Vesper, Solar, Aurora, Thurman and Cleveland Street). The City is working on getting their bills figured out due to a recent change in City employees..

Jack Bascomb made a request for reimbursement of \$18,200.00.

New Business:

HELP Committee Officers were discussed and a motion was made to keep the same slate of officers: <u>Jerry Terjeson</u> – Chairman; <u>Dan Dorran</u> - Vice-Chair; <u>Brad Bixler</u> - Secretary.

Jack Bascomb presented the City of Helix 2022 fund request for \$ 3,486 (see attached application). This project will fund a digital speed sign for the City. The total is \$3,895 and the City will fill in with other funds to fund the project.

Brad Bixler presented the Helix School District 2022 fund request for \$ 3,486 (see attached application). This money will be used for a mural in the weightroom. Jason Hogge has been contacted to create this mural. He is working with the school on some ideas. The estimated cost of the project will be around \$8,000. The School District will fill in with other funds to fund the project.
