THIS PERFORMANCE CONTRACT is dated **Thursday, February 12, 2026** by and between **Tylor & The Train Robbers, LLC** ("COMPANY"), which shall solely furnish the services of **Tylor & the Train Robbers** ("ARTIST"), and **Umatilla County** ("PURCHASER") for the engagement listed below on the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

This Performance Contract between COMPANY and PURCHASER consists of this principal agreement together with the ARTIST'S RIDER (Provided by URL) and any other exhibits and addenda which are provided hereto or provided by ARTIST'S Representative and incorporated herein by this reference (collectively, this "Agreement").

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, PURCHASER and COMPANY hereby agree as follows:

1) Venue:

ATTACHMENTS:

The Additional Terms & Conditions, Artist rider (sent via URL), Gross Split Point with Expenses, and any Company addenda attached hereto form a part of this Agreement and are incorporated herein by this reference.

MATERIAL CHANGES:

Under no circumstances may the Purchaser change any material terms on the facing page of the Agreement, including, without limitation, scaling and Venue for the Date of Engagement without Agent's or Company's prior written consent.

PROMOTION/NAME AND LIKENESS:

(a) Purchaser is being granted the limited right to immediately (and, as applicable, continue to) exploit Artist's approved name, image and logo (hereinafter, the "NIL Rights") solely for purposes of advertising, marketing and promoting the Event and the sale of tickets with respect thereto. Purchaser shall obtain the written approval of Company (e-mail is acceptable) over all announcements, advertisements and promotional material (including any media design) using the Artist's name, likeness, voice and/or logos prior to producing and/or disseminating any such materials. Purchaser shall not advertise the Performance prior to Purchaser's receipt of Agent's (on Company's behalf) written authorization to advertise the Performance.

(b) Without limiting the foregoing, there shall be no sponsorship branding on the stage on which the Performance takes place without Company's prior written approval, which may be withheld in Company's sole discretion.

(c) Purchaser shall not, nor shall Purchaser, authorize others to photograph, record or otherwise reproduce Artist's likeness or image in any manner, nor shall Purchaser record (in any medium) or broadcast (via any means, including, without limitation, radio or internet), or authorize others to record or broadcast, any portion of the Performance without Company's prior written consent.

COMPENSATION & PAYMENTS:

(a) Purchaser warrants and represents that the ticket scaling and fee information provided is accurate and will not be changed without Company's prior written consent in each instance.

(b) Purchaser acknowledges and agrees that ALL payments including deposits are made in **US Dollars**.

(c) Purchaser hereby acknowledges that, except as otherwise expressly set forth herein, each and every payment made hereunder prior to the Date of Engagement (each a "Deposit") is non-refundable.

(d) All performances are **RAIN OR SHINE**. Artist to receive the full agreed-upon performance fee, regardless of weather.

(e) The wages disclosed herein include all expenses Purchaser has agreed to reimburse in accordance with the attached schedule. The Gross Split Point reflects maximum estimated amounts. In the event any of these expenses are higher they will be at Purchasers sole cost.

SECURITY, SAFETY, AND INSURANCE:

Purchaser agrees to provide a safe, secure, and protected environment for both the Artist and the Artist's equipment. For outdoor performances, Purchaser must supply a covered stage or structure that shields the Artist and equipment from wind, rain, and other adverse weather conditions. If, in the sole judgment of the Artist's Representative, the performance area is determined to be unsafe or insufficient to ensure such protection, the Artist reserves the right to cancel the performance while retaining the full contracted performance fee.

Purchaser shall obtain and maintain, from the date hereof through completion of the Engagement, commercial general liability insurance coverage in
