

A closed random traverse was run, beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 32 and through the W 1/h corner of said Section 32, the C 1/h, and the W 1/16. Using information obtained from the Staebler and Hanley surveys, the positions were then calculated for setting the N-3 1/61, C-M-SW 1/61, 3 M 1/16, C-M 1/16.

My basis for bearing was the South line of Section 32, between the Southwest corner and the $\sqrt{1/16}$, as shown on the Staebler survey recorded I - 156 - B.
