

NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

THIS SURVEY WAS MADE AT THE REQUEST OF TRIANGLE CAMP SPRING, INC., HENRY DEMOTTS AND ROSE ANN HAMBERT, TO RECOVER OR RE-ESTABLISH CORNERS OF THREE LAND PARCELS INDICATED ON THIS SURVEY PLAT.

RESEARCH IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE SHOWED A SURVEY MADE IN THE ARREA IN 1955 BY STANLEY WALLILLS. THE HALLILLS MAR REFERRED A FLAT FOR A FLAT FOR AND ASSOCIATES IN 1949, THE VAUGHN FLAT MAP HAS NOT FOUND IN THE COUNTY SURVEY RECORDS, BUT A COPY NAS OBTAINED FROM ROW MANS OF WALLA WALLA WASHINGTON, HR. MAINS NOW OWNS THE SURVEY RECORDS OF CH. STORN-5 AND ASSOCIATES.

THE 'PLAT FOR L.B., VAUGHN', DATED SEPTEMBER 16, 1944, SHONS THE SURVEYED TRACTS HITH BEARINGS AND DISTANCES CONFORMING TO EXISTING DEED DESCRIPTIONS. THE VAUGHN PLAT SHONG CIRCLES AT CORNERS OF THE VARIOUS TRACTS BUT DOES NOT HOLICATE THAT MONMENTS MERE SET. IT SO DIVIDES ROOM EVALUATION THAT THE CURRENT DEED DESCRIPTIONS MERE! PREPARED FROM THE VAUGHN PLAT. I BELIEVE A MAJORITY OF THE MONUMENTS WE FOUND WERE SET AS PART OF THE L.B. VAUGHN SURVEY.

OUR RESEARCH SHOWED THAT IN AUGUST, 1950, EXISTING PARCELS IN THIS AREA WERE DEEDED TO J.M. STEMARD AND ELIZABETH WEBLIA STEMARD. THE STEMARD STEMARD THE LARROWS OWNERS BASED ON DIMENSIONS SHOWN ON THE "PLAT FOR L.B. ("AUGUS". THESE TRANSACTIONS WERE AS APPARENTLY MADE TO CLEAN UP OVERLAPS AND GAPS IN EARLIER DESCRIPTIONS. THE TRANSACTIONS ARE RECORDED IN BOOK 19, PAGES 524 THROUGH 309, DEED RECORDS. MATCHIST CONTINUED OF 1915.

THE ALIGNMENT OF STATE HIGHWAY NO. 204 WAS DETERMINED WITH REFERENCE TO THE BREAU OF FIBULT ROADS CONCETT MONMENTS FOUND AT THE POINT OF CHICATURE AND POINT OF TAKENOT OF THE HIGHWAY CHICA AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT. THE TAKENIST IN AND OUT OF THE CHICA PRE-BASED ON THE EXISTING VISUAL CENTERLINE OF STATE HIGHWAY NO. 204.

THE EXISTING MONUMENTS FOUND ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 26 ARE NOT LOCATED PRECISELY ON THE SECTION LINE AS DETERMINED BY MONUMENTS EXISTING AT THE SOUTH I/4 CORNER AND SOUTHEAST CORNER OF HOWEVER, THE LOCATIONS OF THE EXISTING FOUND MONUMENTS MERE HELD FOR THIS SURVEY.

THIS SURVEY WAS MADE WITH A 2 PERSON CREM USING A LIETZ SET 3 B AUTOMATIC TOTAL STATION WITH STANDARD BERORS OF FLUX OR MINUS 3 SECONDS ANGULAR, AUD 5 MM, PLUS OR MINUS 3 PARTS FER MILLION TIMES DISTANCE FOR LINEAR MEASUREMENT.
