

## SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE AND NARRATIVE

PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO SURVEY THREE PARCELS BELONGING TO THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH IN MILTON-FREEWATER. THE NORTHERN MOST PARCEL WAS OCCUPIED BY A HOUSE, THE CENTER PARCEL IS OCCUPIED BY THE CHURCH AND THE SOUTHERNMOST PIECE IS OCCUPIED BY A COMMUNITY GARDEN.

THE REASON FOR THE SURVEY BEING DONE WAS TO ADJUST THE PROPERTY LINE BETWEEN THE HOUSE PARCEL AND THE CHURCH TO CLEAR A SHED AND CARPORT THAT HAD BEEN BUILT OVER THE PROPERTY LINE SOMETIME IM THE PAST. AS SHOWN THE LINE WAS ADJUSTED TO MAINTAIN A MINIMUM 5.5 FOOT CLEARANCE FROM THE SHED AND CARPORT TO THE PROPERTY LINE.

IN 1995 i HAD SURVEYED THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 7 OF GROSSE'S ADDITION FOR PARTITION 1995-22. I FOUND MY CORNERS SET FOR THAT SURVEY, ONE OF WHICH HAD BEEN RESTABLISHED BY PAUL TOMKINS IN 1997, AND USING THE DIMENSIONS FROM THE PLAT OF GROSSE;S ADDITION LAID OUT THE LINES FOR LOT 7 AND THE ALLEY. THE NORTH LINE OF THE HOUSE PARCEL IS THE SOUTH EDGE OF A PARCEL VACATED AS THE ALLEY IN 1950. AFTER ESTABLISHING THAT LIE I USED THE DEED CALLS TO SET THE LNES FOR THE HOUSE AND CHURCH PARCELS. THERE WAS A DISCREPANCY ON THE LINE ON PIERCE STREET FOR THE GARDEN PARCEL, REEL 280, PAGE 1292, THAT HAD A CALL OF 130.5' M/L TO THE SOUTH LINE OF THE CHURCH PARCEL. PARCEL, BOOK 168, PAGE 595 THERE IS ACTUALLY ONLY 126.90'. ALL THE OTHER DIMENSIONS FIT THE EXISTING LINES AND FENCES.
