


## NARRATIVE:


THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO DO A BOUNDARY LINE ADJUSTMENT TO DECREASE THE SIZE OF TAX LOT 2000, MAP 3N 29 05, TO TWO ACRES WHICH INCLUDES A HOUSE AND OUT BUILDINGS AND TO COMBINE THE REMAINDER WITH TAX LOT 1900 WHICH IS TO BE SOLD TO A NEIGHBORING FARM OPERATION.

BOTH OF THESE TAX LOTS ARE A PORTION OF THE LAND DESCRIBED IN A DEED TO DARWIN AND BARBARA NETHERDA RECORDED ON REEL 115, PAGE 787, UMATILLA COUNTY DEED RECORDS.

I RESET THE CENTER QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 5 FROM A WITNESS CORNER THAT KRUMBEIN SET IN A 1982 SURVEY FOR MARTIN, NETHERDA, AND BRATLIE. I HELD THAT CORNER BECAUSE IT HAS BEEN USED IN NUMEROUS SURVEYS OF PROPERTY TO THE NORTH AND EAST OF IT. I THEN SUBDIVIDED THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER TO ESTABLISH THE WEST LINE OF THE TWO ACRE PARCEL. THE APPROXIMATELY 33 ACRE PARCEL WAS NOT SURVEYED. THE WEST LINE OF THE TWO ACRE PARCEL LIES ABOUT 4 FEET EAST OF AN EXISTING FENCE WHICH RUNS NORTH AND SOUTH. THE AREA USED FOR THE ORIGINAL TAX LOTS ARE FROM COUNTY TAX MAP 3N 29 05 AND ARE APPROXIMATE. NETHERDA'S DEED STATES THAT THE EAST LINE OF TAX LOT 1900 IS THE "NORTH BANK OF THE UMATILLA RIVER, AS SAID RIVER WAS LOCATED ON MARCH 30, 1943."
