Report of Viewers, field notes & Plot of Survey of a County Road Com' at the quarter stake or as near as practicable between Secs 23 & 26 Tp 5 N. R. 34 E. Running Westerly on Sec line to N.W. Cor. of Sec. 28 N.E. Cor. Sec. 29 S.E. Cor. Sec. 20 & S.W. Cor. Sec. 21 Same Tp. & Range

- Report of Viewers. -

To the Hon. County Court
Umatilla County, Oregon:-

We the undersigned, your viewers on Road Survey No. 320. would respectfully report that we met County Surveyor Jno. C. Arnold at the time & place set for the same, & calling to our assistance A. Mc Donald, & L. B. Jay and Elton Waterman, after being qualified, each, according to law, we proceeded to view out & survey said road as prayed for in petition for the same.

We find the road located upon comparatively good ground, & one that is very much needed by the community as an easy outlet to the O. & W. T. R. R.

The road, in general, is located upon section lines.

We therefore recommend that said road 320 become a public highway.

Field Notes of Road Survey No. 320 for Umatilla County, Or.

I met viewers, David Taylor, Frank M. Mansfield & E. A. Dudley, as per order of County Court, March 23^d 1889, & administered the usual viewers oath to each. I called Elton Waterman & L. B. Jay to act as chainmen, & L. B. Jay to mark. As the proposed road runs through a number of fields, fenced with wire, I found it necessary, also, to call A. Mc Donald to drive team & assist in getting stakes spades &c. to proper points. Each assistant was qualified by taking the usual form of oath.

I set initial post 300 links East of $\frac{1}{4}$ S. Cor. bet. Secs. 23 & 26 T. 5 N. R. 34 E. on N.W. hill side, from which a school house bears ^{South} East 48 yards distant. Weather windy & cloudy. Var. 20° 30' E. I turn left 40°, Around head of hollow. Chr.

3.00 Set angle stake at point, & cut A on post in fence S.W. 6 lks.

Turn, thence, Right 85° ascending gently to Sec. line.

7.20 Drove stake on line bet. Secs 23 & 26 at station point, & cut A on post in fence on N side of lane, 29 links N. of Pt. Turn, thence, West on Sec. lines.

9.00 Summit; Descend gently.

17.00 Ravine - 10 runs South. Ascend.

30.00 Summit. Descend gently.

45.30 Ravine.

67.50 O. & W. T. R. R. track, N. 16° 30' W. & S. 16° 30' E. < Approximately >
Ascend.

80.00 Set 1 mile post, 30 links N. of pt. on E. hill side in field.

5.30 $\frac{1}{4}$ S. Co. bet. Secs. 22 & 27.

16.00 Summit. Descend.

20.75 Ravine - δ' ; runs N.W.; Ascend

26.00 Summit. Descend.

27.50 Ravine runs N.; Ascend

31.00 Summit.

38.00 Abrupt descent. - 40'

40.00 Center of hollow, course N.E.

40.50 Ascend hill.

44.00 Summit of steep part; ascend gently.

70.00 Main Summit. Descend gently

80.00 Set 2 mile post, 30 links south of pt. in wheat field.

10.50 Ravine - 10, runs S.W.; Ascend

25.00 Summit; Descend.

30.00 Ravine - 15, runs S.W; Ascend

35.00 Summit, Descend

40.50 Ravine - 6', nearly South; Ascend.

42.70 Int. road in lane N. & S. at Saylor Paris' Res. Set terminus at pt.

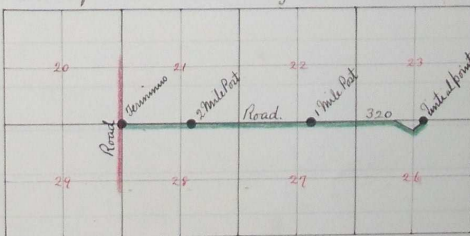
