Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.Corner between Sec.26-27 of Tp. 4 N R 29 E., thecne North along the Section line between Sections 26-27-1332 ft to the 1/16 corner; thence due East 5316 ft to the North 1/16 corner between Sec.25-26, Tp.4 N R 29 E W M.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above entitled matter be heard at the regular January term, for theyear 1921 of said County Court, at the County Court room in the courthouse in Pendle ton, Oregon.

That a copy be posted on the bulletin board at the north entrance of the Court house, in the city of Pendleton, Umatilla county state of Oregon, the same be, the **XXXXX** place where the county court is held that three copies be posted in a public place and in in plain view of the public and, the vicinity of said proposed county road.
