Willard Bradley, County Surveyor, claims to have found a "stake and stone" at this corner in Survey No. 411, found in the old Record of Private Survey Books, (April, 1916).

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: None. Falls in old CRP field, previously farmed. I reestablish this corner by single proportion measurement between the Northeast and Southeast corners of Section 17.

MONUMENT SET: At reestablished corner point set a 2 1/2" brass cap on 1 1/4 by 30" galvanized iron pipe 30" in the ground and surrounded with earth mound. Cap is marked as shown in Monument Marking Detail. Set steel fence post 2 1/2' South of corner with Witness sign attached.

New accessories:

A silver Deep-1 magnet bears N 52°28' E, 29.4'.

A silver Deep-1 magnet bears S 45°27' E, 36.5'.

A silver Deep-1 magnet bears S 48°23' W, 31.1'.

A silver Deep-1 magnet bears N 23°54' W, 32.5'.

Placed bearing object signs with the Deep-1 magnets, below ground. Deep-1 magnets are buried 18" below ground.

Bearings to accessories are State Plane Grid bearings.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Corner is located on North slope in old CRP field. There is a North-South fence line on the 1/16 th section line 1/4 mile to the West.
