The corner was originally set by Josiah A. Burnett under Contract No. 92 dated September 12, 1860. His record Reads: Set post and drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions. Surveyor Bill Wells, under County Survey 93-54-C found the remains of a charred stake 18" below the surface at the intersection of old fences. He held the fence intersection as the best available evidence. His record reads: Set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galv. iron pipe. 27 inches in the ground with a mound of stone to the cap. See his filed corner certificate for calls to his reference objects.

Monument and accessories found: (Condition and source) I found the brass cap set by Wells in the mound in good condition. The fence corner has been burned but is still standing. The fences are no longer maintained since the adjacent fields are in CRP. I did not tie his references.
