Lincoln Wilkes in the Diminished Indian Reservation Survey states: Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 2 ins. diam., for cor. of Tps. 1 and 2 N. Rs. 32 and 33 E. with brass cap. Mr. Bill Wells in survey 94-109-C found the Wilkes monument and reports a GLO Brass capped reference monument 40 feet south and a BIA brass capped Reference monument 12 feet north. Mr. Wells stated that both references were of unknown origin. Mr. Brian Siebold, under special instructions dated March 16, 2000 also found the Wilkes Brass Cap but reported the reference monuments to be a brass cap on a 2" iron post by Wilkes bearing North 0°39'35" East 40.00 feet and a brass cap on a 1 1/2" diam. iron pipe by C.E. Redfield bears South 0°39'11" West 12.00 feet;
