Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by David P. Thompson under contract #106 dated August 16, 1864. His record reads: Set post for 1/4 sec. corner in mound of earth with charred stake, pits, & trench.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

I found decayed wood at the intersection of fences running north, south and west. This wood was probably a decayed fence post, however, this location is the best available evidence of the original corner point.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 30" galvanized iron pipe stamped as shown in the diagram above at the intersection of the fences flush with the surface of the ground. I set a 6' steel guard post with a monument sign attached about 1 foot north of the monument.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" iron rebars with 1 1/4" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below: an iron rebar bears N01°14'52"E, 45.41 feet;

an iron rebar bears S86°23'25"E, 63.98 feet; an iron rebar bears S01°46'27"W, 49.31 feet; an iron rebar bears N79°05'17"W, 122.55 feet under the existing fence;

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS in static mode.
