

MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) At the computed point, I set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above to bedrock. The cap is 21" below the surface.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" iron rebars with 1 1/4" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below: an iron rebar bears N12°00'59"W, 211.10 feet in a rock outcropping;

an iron rebar bears N27°01'16"E, 193.50 feet in a rock outcropping;

an iron rebar bears S88°35'05"E, 28.46 feet 2 feet below the surface of the field;

an iron rebar bears S32°19'34"W, 68.47 feet in a mound of field stones;

The monument was set and references tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
