History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Jacob C. Cooper under GLO contract number 397, dated July 1, 1881. Surveyor General record states:

A thorn tree 3 ins diam which I marked for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor $\frac{1}{4}$ S on the E and W faces, from which:

A balm 28 ins diam bears S80°W, 15 lks dist marked %S BT No other suitable trees in limits and raised a mound of stone alongside.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument or accessories.

See map of survey dated September, 1989.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 27 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees: A 33 inch diameter White Fir bears N45°E, 82.45 feet marked % S30 BT A 28 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S29°W, 56.62 feet marked % S25 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet South with Land Survey Monument sign attached.

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 3 ft. base to top of cap.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
