
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2%" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 30 inches in the ground, from which:


New Bearing Trees: A 10 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S33°E, 16.80 feet marked S1/16 S30 BT A 13 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S12°W, 50.5 feet marked S1/16 S25 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet South with Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary signs attached.
