## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Jacob C. Cooper under GLO contract number 397, dated July 1, 1881. Surveyor General record states: Set post 3½ ft. long 3 ins square 18 ins in the ground on steep mountainous side sloping E for ½ sec cor marked ½S on E and W faces from which:





No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument or accessories.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 20 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees: A 28 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S25°E, 89.6 feet marked ½ S31 BT A 20 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S68°W, 46.0 feet marked ½ S36 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with Land Survey Monument and Property boundary signs attached.

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 3 ft. base to top of cap.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 7, 1989. Witnesses: Jeff Petersen and Rick Robinson.



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I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
