Reestablished corner position on parallel of latitude between recovered S.W. corner of Section 34 and recovered corner at the Southeast corner of Section 36, holding North-South field berm for departure at corner point. At position determined by survey, set a 2 3/8" brass cap on 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with cap 15" below ground level in a farmed field. Monument marked as shown in monument marking detail.

A silver Deep-1 magnet buried 24" below ground level bears North 55° East, 35.6 feet. A blue Deep-1 magnet buried 24" below ground level bears South 35° East, 41.2 feet.
