A 3/4" brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" 1 foot above ground in UECA power pole No. 330000 bears North 70° East, 48.3 feet.

A 3/4" brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" 1 foot above ground in UECA power pole No. 330001 bears North 07 1/2° East, 82.8 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", bears South 57° East, 44.7 feet.

A $5/8" \ge 30"$ iron rebar in fence line with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", bears South 63° West, 40.8 feet. Set steel fence post 1 foot beyond this accessory with witness sign attached.

Attached bearing object signs to all rebar accessories and power poles with brass washers.
