MONUMENT SET:

At mean intersection of old fences extending East-West and North, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 26" in the ground, surrounded with a mound of earth. Cap is marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail".

New Accessories:

A 60 penny spike driven in the center of a pitched 30" sawn pine stump bears N 49°E., 178.2'. Measured to 60 penny spike.

A 7" Ponderosa pine bears S 69° E., 109.4' scribed "1/4 S19 BT".

A 8" Ponderosa pine bears S 27°W., 89.1' scribed "1/4 S24 BT".

"XBO" chiseled in a 44" by 20" by 12 above ground rock bears S 85° W., 21.5'. Measured to the "X".

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" nail to face of blaze, and a "bearing object" sign attached. Attached "bearing object" sign to the sawn stump accessory. Measurements to new bearing trees are to the center of tree.

Set steel fence post East of Corner monument and attached "witness" sign.
