Monument Set (Procedures and Description): Set a  $1 1/2" \ge 30"$  iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap marked as indicated in the monument detail, 24" in the ground at the location of the axle skein, and 5/8" rebar. The pine and the tamarack don't appear to be the original bearing trees because the style of scribing and the nail in the x are not similar to that found on other corners. The only record that was found was on a map of survey filed by James Hambleton, dated, 2/15/77, (file No. N-65 Umatilla County Records) in which he indicates that he found the original GLO corner.

New Accessories: A steel fence post bears N. 3.0 ft. with a Land Survey Monument sign attatched.

Location & Comments: The corner is on the level about 200' E. of the Lincton Mtn. road.
