Previous Renewals/Surveys, etc. The original survey was made by George S. Pershin under contract No.332, dated July 29th, 1879. He set a basalt stone 16 x 10 x 5 on N. E. face of spur for 1/4 Sec. Cor. A fir, 18 ins. diam. brs. N.35°W., 55 lks. dist. A fir, 13 ins. diam. brs. S.6°W., 27 lks. dist. Charles L. & William C. Campbell retraced this survey under contract No. 733, dated March 22, 1901, and found the corner as described by Pershin they made no changes. Hambleton searched for the corner in 1977 but did not find it (map No. N-65).

Monument(s) & Accessories Found: (Condition and Source) Found a basalt stone 15 x 9 x 5 with 1/4 clearly marked on it laying loosely on the N. E. face of a spur a rotted stump bears  $5.6^{\circ}W.$ , 17.8 ft.. The tree that came from the stump we found 50' down the hill it had evidence of scribing on it.

Monument Set (Procedures and Description): Set a 1/2" x 30" iron pipe with a 2 1/2 " brass cap marked as indicated in the monument detail 14" in the ground with a mound of rocks to the top. Set the corner stone beside the monument as a witness.
