A 9" diam. Douglas Fir bears North 62° East, a distance of 21.40 feet, marked NE 1/16 S26 BT. A 19" Douglas Fir bears South 38° East, a distance of 19.20 feet, marked NE 1/16 S26 BT.

Set steel fencepost 0.5 feet East.

Falls approx. 40 ft. downslope of forest road.
