No evidence of this corner was recovered after a diligent search of a 150' radius around the calculated corner position. The area has been logged years ago and has been burnt.

This corner was re-established by single proportion measure between the Southeast and Northeast corners of Section 25.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 2 1/2" by 30" galv. iron pipe 24" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees: A 15" white fir bears N 90°E - 15.1' scribed 1/4S30BT. A 7" white fir bears N 22°E - 16.9', scribed 1/4S30BT. A 6" white fir bears N 74°1/2 W - 24.9', scribed 1/4S25BT. A 5" Douglas fir bears S 51°W - 17.9', scribed 1/4S25BT.
