Description of corner evidence found: I found a 36" fir with open face and $\frac{1}{2}S$ scribed on face fitting GLO notes of 12" fir bearing N 15 W, 10 lks. dist. Also found an old rotted stump fitting GLO description of 14" fir bearing S 20 E, 17 lks. dist. Using the GLO bearings and distances from these trees I found a 1" iron pin approx. 3" below the surface of the ground at the described location of the $\frac{1}{2}$ corner. I accepted this iron pin, even though I found no record of its existence, as being a perpetuation of the original $\frac{1}{2}$ corner.
