Set tamarack post on SW face of hill for 1/4 Section corner from which:

A tamarack 10 in. di. brs N 34°W 34 lks dist. A tamarack 8 in. di. brs S 50°E 12 lks dist.

In 1976, an original bearing tree for this corner was recovered as noted on Survey No. M-115-B.

In 1978, the NW original bearing tree was recovered and the corner remonumented as noted on corner certificate 8-729.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe, set flush with the ground from which:

A 14" white fir bears N 14°W, 21.37' with partly healed blaze. A 12" white fir bears S 64°E, 26.83' with partly healed blaze.

The bearing trees noted above were marked by Douglas M. Ferguson as noted on corner certificate Q-729. These bearing trees have USFS bearing tree signs attached.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Cleaned up debris around the existing momnument and set steel fence post West of corner and attached witness corner sign.

Marked two new bearing trees:

A 16" douglas fir bears N 37 1/2°E, 45.1' scribed 1/4 S28 BT. A 7" white fir bears S 54°E, 13.7' scribed 1/4 S33 BT.

Attached bearing object signs to the new bearing trees.
