Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2" O.D. galvanized iron pipe by 24" long, 2" out of ground, origin unknown.

This pipe has been used as the corner on all surveys in this area since the 1950's.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position of the found 2" 0.D. pipe, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" by 30" galvanized iron pipe 24" in the ground, and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried old pipe horizontally South of the new corner monument.

Marked 3 new bearing trees:

A 4" Englemann spruce bears N 5°E, 4.4', scribed "X" at breast height and BT at base. A 8" Englemann spruce bears N 84°E, 34.1', scribed 1/4 S26 BT. A 4" western larch bears S 40°E, 4.0', scribed "X" at breast height and BT at base. Southeast corner of Parcel 2, Partition Plat no. 1991-07 bears East 57.0'.

Placed bearing object signs on bearing trees.

Set steel fence post 3' East of corner with a witness corner sign attached.
