Description of corner evidence found:

I found no trace of this corner nor its bearing trees. The area around this section corner has been cleared or logged very heavy many years ago and thus left no trace of the original corner; some trees are growing back, but most of the area is still a meadow.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

After an extensive search and making ties to the original GLO calls to a spring branch nearby, I determined the corner to be a lost corner, thus I re-established the corner position by proportionate measurements and set a 2" galv. iron pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap at the position determined to be the section corner common to Sections 28, 29 & 32, 33 from which I set the following new bearing trees: A 9" fir bears S 37 W, 48.91 feet, scribed T 4 N R 37 E S 32 BT. A 6" spruce bears N 86 W, 61.13 ft, scribed T 4 N R 37 E S 29 BT. A 16" spruce bears N 26 E, 33.15 ft., scribed T 4 N R 37 E S 28 BT. No trees available in Section 33.
