In 1978, Douglas M. Ferguson searched for this corner and found no acceptable evidence of it's original location. Ferguson re-established the corner by single proportion measurement. See corner certificate No. 0-733.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2 1/2" brass cap on a 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe with top of cap set 8" below ground. The corner monument is on the South edge of a gravel road. From the found corner monument:

A 12" Englemann spruce bears N 68°E 25.67' with partly healed blaze. A 12" white fir bears S 38°W 96.83' with healed blaze.

The bearing trees noted above were marked by Douglas M. Ferguson, and have USFS bearing tree tags attached.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Recovered the corner monument, noted cap markings, then placed a mound of stone over the corner. Set steel fence post 3.2' South of monument and attached witness corner sign.

Marked two additional bearing trees:

A 18" white fir bears N 09°W 55.7' scribed 1/4 S33 BT. A 11" douglas fir bears S 45°W 35.9' scribed 1/4 S33 BT.

Placed bearing object signs on the two new bearing trees.
