I found no trace of the original post nor the bearing trees, however I did find a 1<sup>‡</sup>" iron pipe at the <sup>‡</sup> corner location; the iron pipe being harmonious to the topography call in the original GLO notes, I tyed the position of this iron pipe to my co-ordinate system and even though I found no record of this iron pipe being set, there is evidence that it is being used as the <sup>‡</sup> corner and the collateral evidence helps to confirm its position thus I accepted it as the perpetuation of the original <sup>‡</sup> corner and continued with my retracement survey.
