

Original survey was made by Wm. H. Odell, US Deputy Surveyor, under contract No. 114, dated July 2, 1866. He set a post for $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner common to sections 32 & 33. He set the following bearing trees: A pine 12" dia. bears N 84 W, 18 1ks. A fir 10" dia. bears N 81 E, 26 1ks.

Description of corner evidence found:

I made an extensive search in the area of this $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, but found no trace of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ corner as the area has been logged two or three times since the original corner was set in 1866; thus I have determined the original corner to have been lost and continued my survey on that basis, by using proportionate distances along the line common to sections 32 and 33.
