Found 2 1/2" brass cap on 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe protruding 4" from the ground from which:

A 15" douglas fir bears N 52°E 60.55' with healed blaze. A 15" white fir bears S 65°W 40.66' with partly healed blaze.

The bearing tress noted above were marked by Douglas M. Ferguson in 1978. The trees have USFS bearing tree tags attached.
