## History of original corner establishment:

The original survey was made by George E. Pershin under contract No. 304, dated Sept. 19, 1878. He set a fir post on level for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. corner. He set the following bearing trees: A tamarack 22" dia. bears N 30 E, 10 lks. dist. A fir 6" dia. bears S 65 W, 11 lks. dist.



## Description of corner evidence found:

I made an extensive search in the area of this  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner, but due to the area being heavily logged several times since the original corner was set, I found no trace of evidence of any kind for this corner, thus determined the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner to be a lost corner.

Description of monument and accessories Lestablished to perpetu original location of this corner:
