History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by George S. Pershin, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contact No. 304, dated September 19, 1878.

The original notes state:

Set Fir post on level for corner to Sections 3, 4, 33, and 34 from which:

tamarack 12 in diam. brs N 34°E 54 1ks. dist. tamarack 11 in. diam. brs S 4% E 20 1ks. dist. fir 18 in. diam. brs S 52°M 33 1ks dist. tamarack 14 in. diam. brs N 62°M 31 1ks. dist.

In 1978, Douglas M. Ferguson recovered a 24° by 10° by 4° stone set 14° in the dround and after making a thorough search of the area, determined the stone to be a gepteuation of the original corner location. See corner certificate 0-737.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 24" by 10" by 4" painted stone, set 14" in the ground.

I searched for original bearing tree evidence for approximately 1 1/4 hours without success, and accept the found stone as a perpetuation of the original corner location.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position of the center of the found stone, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" by 30" galvanized iron pipe 24" in ground, and surrounded with a mound of earth. Placed found stone in the new mound on the East side of the new

monument.

Marked four new bearing trees:

Form

A 5" western larch bears N 09 1/2°E 40.2' scribed "X" at breast height and "BT" at base of tree. A 12" alpine fir bears S 29 1/2°E, 75.1', scribed T3N R37E S3 BT. A 6" white fir bears S 35°W, 14.2', scribed T3N R37E S4 BT. A 15" western larch bears N 73 1/2°W, 29.6', scribed T4N R37E S33 BT.

Placed bearing object signs on each of the new bearing trees.

Set steel fence post North of corner and attached a witness corner sign.
