Description of corner evidence found:

Original stone not found; corner on a steep N.W. slope, corner stone has apparently eroded out and rolled down the slope. A fire has gone through the area some 40-50 years ago.

Found 16 in. pine, dead and down, with BT scribing visible. Tree has rolled down the slope. There has been no substantial growth of the tree since it was scribed. It is determined that this is the Sec. 2 BT; therefore corner is positioned at record call from approx. original position of the tree. No other bearing trees conclusive, due to fire.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 3"x30" galv. iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown on the diagram. Set 20 inches in the ground. From which: A fir 12 inches dia. bears N9°E, 36.2 ft. scribed T4S R30E S1 BT. A pine 10 inches dia. bears S14°E, 30.3 ft. scribed T4S R30E S 12 BT. A fir 15 inches dia. bears S39°W, 47.2 ft. scribed T4S R30E S 11 BT. A fir 8 inches dia. bears N56°W, 27.6 ft. scribed X BT. Set steel post with warning sign 4 ft. North from corner. Nailed bearing tree signs and brass washers stamped PLS 848 to each tree. Painted a red band around each tree.
