Set 3"x30" galv iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown on the diagram, set 16 inches in the ground and raised a mound of stone around the pipe. Set original stone South alongside pipe.

From which: A pine 14 in. dia. bears S39°E, 120.4 ft. scribed 1/4 S 7 BT. No bearing tree available on West side. Set steel post with warning sign 5 ft. North from corner. Nailed bearing tree sign and brass washer stamped PLS 848 to tree. Painted red band around tree.
