History of original corner establishment: Corner originally established by George Pershin in 1882: Set a basalt stone 15"x12"x8", 10" in the ground on a slight south slope marked with 4 notches on south and one notch on east edge from which bears:

**Description of corner evidence found:** I found the brass capped BLM Monument in a mound of stones and properly marked. Recent road construction has destroyed the remains of the original S.E. bearing tree as well as the new one set in 1978.

I found the following bearing trees:

A 45" ponderosa pine bears  $N28^{\circ}E$ , 134.6 ft. (record 205 lks.). The upper blaze has been partly opened, the lower blaze healed over. No marks are visible.

A 36" ponderosa pine bears S78<sup>0</sup>W, 38.5 ft. (record 113 1ks.). Both blazes are healed.

A 23" ponderosa pine bears  $N76^{O}W$ , 54.1 ft. (record 56 lks.). The upper blaze has been partly opened, the lower blaze healed over.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: From the brass capped corner monument I blaze and scribe the following tree:

A 12" ponderosa pine bears  $559^{\circ}E$ , 105.7 feet scribed "T4S R3OE S13 BT" on a single blaze. The centerline of the new road is 30 feet East of the corner, and runs in a N-S direction.

Compass declination: 20°East
