Description of corner evidence found:

Original stone not found.

Found remains of 10 in. pine with 1949 location poster and blaze with small US stamped in blaze. Growth rings indicate this tree was blaced about 1949. Due to logging in area, no evidence found; therefore, set corner position by proportion.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 3"x30" galv. iron pipe with 3" brass cap, stamped as shown on the diagram, set 20 inches in the ground. From which A fir 16 in. dia. bears N18°E, 9.4 ft. scribed 1/4 S 17 BT. A fir 20 in. dia. bears 552°W, 6.3 ft. scribed 1/4 S 18 BT. Set steel posts with warning and boundary signs 5 ft. East and 5 ft. South from corner. Nailed bearing tree signs and brass washers stamped PLS 848 to each tree. Painted red band around each tree.
