Description of corner evidence found:

Found basalt stone 12"x10"x8" set in mound of stone. 1/4 on West face.

No evidence of original bearing trees.

Accepted center of 12"x10"x8" stone as the 1/4 cor. position.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 3"x30" galv.iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown on the diagram. Set 16"in the ground and raised a mound of stone and earth around the pipe. From which:

A pine 9" dia. bears N3°W, 35.2 ft. scribed 1/4 5 2**8** BT. A pine 10" dia. bears N74°E, 25.9 ft. scribed 1/4 5 2**4** BT. Set steel posts with warning and boundary signs 5 ft. North and 5 ft. East from corner. Nailed bearing tree signs and brass washers stamped PLS 848 to each tree. Painted red band around each tree.
