## Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence found. An old fence line courses N70°E - S70°W, approx. 50 ft. North of cor. position. The original mound of stones and original stone were probably placed in the old fence line.

No bearing trees originally taken.

Since no evidence is found, corner is set by proportion.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 3"x30" galv. iron pipe with 3" brass cap, stamped as shown on the diagram, set 6 in. in the ground and raised a mound of stone and earth around the pipe. (Mound is 8' x 24".) From which: A pine 20" dia. bears N42°W, 102.6 ft. scribed T45, R30E, S23 BT. A pine 16" dia. bears S50°E, 63.0 ft. scribed T45, R30E, S25 BT. A pine 10" dia. bears S29°W, 93.4 ft. scribed T45, R30E, S26 BT. No bearing tree available in NE quadrant. Set steel posts with warning and boundary signs 6 ft. West and 6 ft. East from corner. Nailed bearing tree signs and brass washers stamped PLS 848 on each tree. Painted red band around each tree.
