CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established in 1882 by George S. Pershin under General Land OfficeContract No. 430. Surveyor General's records state: Set a basalt stone 16x12x8 ins. 11 ins. in ground on slight NE slope for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marked 1/4 on N. face.

- A pine 15 ins. dia. brs. N50°E 100 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S BT.
- A pine 28 ins. dia. brs. 55°W 21 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 16"x12"x8" stone in a mound of stone, no marks visible. Found stump hole S10°W, 14 ft. from stone. Found 30" pine stump, no scribing visible, bears N60°E, 66 ft. from stone. Georgia Pacific location tag states "Scribing visible in 1970." Accepted stone as position of the 1/4 corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: Set 3"x30" galv. iron pipe with 3"obrass cap stamped as shown on the diagram. Set pipe 16 inches in the ground and raised a mound of stone around the pipe. From which: A pine 18 inches dia. bears N76°E, 116.8 ft. scribed 1/4 S 24 BT. A pine 14 inches dia. bears S49°E, 42.3 ft. scribed 1/4 S 25 BT. Set steel post with warning sign 5 ft. North from corner. Nailed bearing tree signs and brass washers stamped PLS 848 on each tree.

Painted a red band around each tree.
