History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by George S. Pershin under G.L.O. contract no. 430 dated March 23, 1882. He set a basalt stone 20"x12"x6" 15" in the ground marked ½ on the west side. From which:

A Pine, 30" dia., N16ºE, 61 1ks

No other tree was available. He raised a stone mound alongside the corner.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 20"x11"x6" with no marks evident and a stone mound. From the corner:

A pine stump, burned and rotted, approximately $3\frac{1}{2}$ ' diameter, N140E, 42.2 ft. with no scribing remaining.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In place of the stone set a 2¹/₂"x30" alum. pipe with a 3" alum. cap containing a magnet and marked:

Buried the original stone alongside and built a stone mound around the monument. From the corner: New BTs A P. Pine, 9" dia., N7340E, 45.3 ft. marked ½ S35 BT A.D. Fir, 8" dia., S5520N, 22.4 ft. marked ½ S34 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" stripe painted red, a BT tag and an "Attention" sign. The new BTs have alum. "PLS 1832" washer nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with an "Attention" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and theodolite; bearings are true. September 18, 1984.
