A 6" and 8" double juniper bears S 21  $1/2^{\circ}$  W, 129.8 feet scribed "1/4 S1 BT", on double blaze.

A 22" ponderosa pine bears N 56  $1/2^{\circ}$  W, 64.9 feet scribed "1/4 S36 BT", on double blaze.

Set steel fence post East of corner with witness sign attached. Tagged bearing trees with bearing object signs.
