Corner originally set by Deputy Surveyors Odell & Lewis under contract No. 110 dated February 7th, 1865. Their record reads: Set charred post Cor. for 1/4 sec.; dug pits & raised mound as per instructions. John Kimbrell in the survey recorded in Book 1, Page 325 of the Record of Private Surveys said "set stone 14 x 7 x 3 for 1\4 sec. cor.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

Found a broken stone $7 \times 7 \times 3$ at the foot of a railroad tie fence corner. I could find no other stone in the area. There was evidence of other rotted off posts at this corner indicating long term use of this position.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the daigram above on a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, 30" at the foot of the railroad tie fence corner. I buried the stone along side.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24", green coated, iron rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

a rebar bears N87°56'10"E, 26.37 feet, 20" beneath the surface;

a rebar bears S88°24'14"E, 9.71 feet, 20" beneath the surface;

a rebar bears S45°27'07"E, 12.08 feet, 20" beneath the surface;

a rebar bears S2°58'59"W, 12.32 feet, 20" beneath the surface;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
