History of original corner establishment: In 1872, under G.L.O. Contract No. 176, George Williams set post for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor between secs 4 & 5 from which A yew 5 in. dia. bears E. 41 lks (27.1!). A yew 8" dia. bears S21° W 38 lks (25.1!).

In 1899 a resurvey was performed by George R. & William E. Campbell under G.L.O. Contract No. 699. They found the post and witnessed and marked as before described.
