A Spruce 11" dia. bears N29<sup>0</sup>E 30.8 ft., scribed ½ S4 BT.

Attached 54-3 and 54-4 signs to both BTs. Attached brass washer stamped LS 1294 to foot blaze of both BTs. Painted blazes and 6" band around both BTs red.
